**THE DONALD JAMIESON FELLOWSHIP
IN STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING
2010/2011**

Applications are invited for the \$5000 Donald Jamieson Fellowship in structural engineering tenable for the twelve-month period commencing October 1, 2010.

The recipient must be registered as a full time graduate student in structural engineering at a Canadian university during the 2010-2011 academic year. Preference will be given to those who already have engineering or engineering-related experience, and are members of the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering.

Mr. Donald Jamieson, a prominent structural engineer in British Columbia, was chair of the Organizing Committee for the 1984 Vancouver Congress of the International Association for Bridge and Structural Engineering. The Donald Jamieson Fellowship, which was established in his memory in 1986, is mainly funded from the surplus generated by the Congress.

A complete application includes a letter from the applicant, a curriculum vitae, and copies of university transcripts. Letters of reference will not be considered. **Applications must be submitted by January 31, 2010 to:**
