Whitman Wright Award for Excellence in IT in Civil Engineering Terms of Reference

1. The award consisting of a bronze medal and a scroll will be given annually to an engineer for outstanding work in Information Technology in Civil Engineering.

The award has been instituted to recognize outstanding work. Therefore, if during any year the selection committee does not find a candidate, then the award shall not be given in that year.

2. The award is meant to recognize such engineers who have made a significant contribution in the advancement of application of Information Technology in Civil Engineering. Areas of significant contribution might include any one or more of the following categories:

- (i) Original research
- (ii) Significant development
- (iii) Innovative application
- (iv) Outstanding teaching

3. Only members of the CSCE or any other member society of the Engineering Institute of Canada will be qualified to receive the award.
4. Selection of an appropriate candidate will be made by an Awards Selection Committee (ASC) that will be a sub-committee of the CSCE Honours and Fellowships Committee (HFC). The ASC shall consist of a minimum of three CSCE members appointed by the Committee on Innovation and IT in Civil Engineering, subject to the approval of the HFC. The ASC reports directly and only to the HFC.

For the purpose of selecting a candidate the Awards Selection Committee shall invite nominations from the membership of the CSCE.

The selected candidate shall be recommended to the Honours and Awards Committee of the CSCE which will make the final decision on the award.
